Section 1. Paragraph (eeee) is added to subsection (4) of section 320.08056, Florida Statutes, to read:

320.08056 Specialty license plates.

(4) The following license plate annual use fees shall be collected for the appropriate specialty license plates:

(eeee) Fallen Law Enforcement Officers license plate, \$25. Section 2. Subsection (83) is added to section 320.08058, Florida Statutes, to read:

320.08058 Specialty license plates.

- (83) FALLEN LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS LICENSE PLATES.-
- (a) Notwithstanding s. 45, chapter 2008-176, Laws of Florida, as amended by s. 21, chapter 2010-223, Laws of Florida, and s. 320.08053(1), the department shall develop a Fallen Law Enforcement Officers license plate as provided in s. 320.08053(2) and (3) and this section. The plates must bear the colors and design approved by the department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the plate, and the words "A Hero Remembered Never Dies" must appear at the bottom of the plate.

and Kids Foundation, Inc., which may use a maximum of 10 percent of the proceeds to promote and market the plate.
