Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 316.0777, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

and automated traffic law enforcement system; public records exemption.—Recorded images made by an automated traffic law enforcement system are confidential and shall be made available only to the alleged violator and governmental and law enforcement agencies for purposes of adjudicating a violation of law, for statistical purposes, or for other governmental purposes. A recorded image evidencing a violation of law may be admissible in a proceeding resulting from the issuance of a citation. This section is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and is repealed on October 2, 2019, unless reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the

Legislature.

Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public necessity that images obtained through the use of an automated traffic law enforcement system be made confidential and exempt

The release of such images 31 held by an agency and personal identifying information in data 32 generated from such images could enable a third party to track a 33 person's movements and compile a history on where a person has 34 driven. This exemption is necessary because the public 35 disclosure of such information constitutes an unwarranted 36 invasion into the personal life and privacy of a person. The 37 harm from disclosing such information outweighs the public 38 benefit that can be derived from widespread and unregulated 39 public access to such information. 40 Section 3. This act shall take effect on the same date that SB or similar legislation takes effect, if such legislation 41 42 is adopted in the same legislative session or an extension 43 thereof and becomes a law.
