Section 1. Paragraph (eeee) is added to subsection (4) of section 320.08056, Florida Statutes, to read:

320.08056 Specialty license plates.-

(4) The following license plate annual use fees shall be collected for the appropriate specialty license plates:

(eeee) Pan-Hellenic Sorority and Fraternity license plate,

Section 2. Subsection (83) is added to section 320.08058, Florida Statutes, to read:

320.08058 Specialty license plates.-

(83) PAN-HELLENIC LICENSE PLATES.-

(a) Notwithstanding s. 320.08053(1) and s. 45, chapter 2008-176, Laws of Florida, as amended by s. 21, chapter 2010-223, Laws of Florida, the department shall develop a Pan-Hellenic Sorority and Fraternity license plate for each of the following sororities and fraternities, subject to s. 320.08053(2) and (3), as provided in this section:

- 1. Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc.
- a. The annual use fees collected from the sale of the plate under this subparagraph shall be distributed to Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc., to promote community awareness and action through educational, economic, and cultural service activities.
- b. Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity, Inc., may use up to 10 percent of the annual use fees collected for administrative costs and marketing of the plate.
 - 2. Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc.
- a. The annual use fees collected from the sale of the plate under this subparagraph shall be distributed to Alpha Kappa

 Alpha Sorority, Inc., to promote community awareness and action through educational, economic, and cultural service activities.
- b. Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., may use up to 10 percent of the annual use fees collected for administrative costs and marketing of the plate.
 - 3. Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc.
- a. The annual use fees collected from the sale of the plate under this subparagraph shall be distributed to Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., to promote community awareness and action through educational, economic, and cultural service activities.
- b. Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc., may use up to 10 percent of the annual use fees collected for administrative costs and marketing of the plate.
 - 4. Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc.
- a. The annual use fees collected from the sale of the plate under this subparagraph shall be distributed to Omega Psi Phi

 Fraternity, Inc., to promote community awareness and action through educational, economic, and cultural service activities.

b. Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., may use up to 10 percent of the annual use fees collected for administrative costs and marketing of the plate.

- 5. Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc.
- a. The annual use fees collected from the sale of the plate under this subparagraph shall be distributed to Delta Sigma

 Theta Sorority, Inc., to promote community awareness and action through educational, economic, and cultural service activities.
- b. Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., may use up to 10 percent of the annual use fees collected for administrative costs and marketing of the plate.
 - 6. Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc.
- a. The annual use fees collected from the sale of the plate under this subparagraph shall be distributed to Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc., to promote community awareness and action through educational, economic, and cultural service activities.
- b. Phi Beta Sigma Fraternity, Inc., may use up to 10 percent of the annual use fees collected for administrative costs and marketing of the plate.
 - 7. Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc.
- a. The annual use fees collected from the sale of the plate under this subparagraph shall be distributed to Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc., to promote community awareness and action through educational, economic, and cultural service activities.
- b. Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc., may use up to 10 percent of the annual use fees collected for administrative costs and marketing of the plate.
 - 8. Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Inc.
 - a. The annual use fees collected from the sale of the plate

under this subparagraph shall be distributed to Sigma Gamma Rho
Sorority, Inc., to promote community awareness and action
through educational, economic, and cultural service activities.

- b. Sigma Gamma Rho Sorority, Inc., may use up to 10 percent of the annual use fees collected for administrative costs and marketing of the plate.
 - 9. Iota Phi Theta Fraternity, Inc.
- a. The annual use fees collected from the sale of the plate under this subparagraph shall be distributed to Iota Phi Theta Fraternity, Inc., to promote community awareness and action through educational, economic, and cultural service activities.
- b. Iota Phi Theta Fraternity, Inc., may use up to 10 percent of the annual use fees collected for administrative costs and marketing of the plate.
- (b) Upon a sorority or a fraternity meeting the requirements of s. 320.08053(2) and (3), the department shall develop the specialty license plate for that sorority or fraternity.
- (c) The department shall retain all of the annual use fees collected from the sale each of the plates listed in paragraph (a) until all startup costs for developing and issuing a sorority's or fraternity's plate are recovered. Thereafter, 5 percent of the fees collected from the sale of each plate shall be distributed to the United Negro College Fund to provide scholarships for minority students and general scholarship funds for Florida private historically black colleges and universities. The remaining proceeds from the sale of a sorority's or fraternity's plates shall be distributed to the respective organization and used as provided in subparagraphs
