7	WHEREAS, the Holocaust, the state-sponsored, systematic
8	persecution and annihilation of European Jewry by Nazi Germany
9	and its collaborators between 1933 and 1945, resulted in the
10	murder of six million Jews, and
11	WHEREAS, in addition, Roma (Gypsies) and Poles were
12	targeted for decimation for racial, ethnic, or national reasons,
13	and millions more, including persons with disabilities,
14	homosexuals, Jehovah's Witnesses, Soviet prisoners of war, and
15	political dissidents, suffered grievous oppression and death
16	under Nazi tyranny, and
17	WHEREAS, the history of the Holocaust offers an opportunity
18	to reflect on the moral responsibilities of individuals,
19	societies, and governments, particularly to remain vigilant
20	against hatred, persecution, and tyranny, and
21	WHEREAS, pursuant to an Act of Congress (Public Law No. 96-
22	388, October 7, 1980), the United States Holocaust Memorial
23	Council has designated Sunday, April 27, through Sunday, May 4,
24	2014, as the "Days of Remembrance" for the victims of the

25 Holocaust, including the Day of Remembrance known as Yom HaShoah 26 on April 28, 2014, and WHEREAS, in memory of the victims of the Holocaust, in 27 28 honor of its survivors, and in utmost gratitude for the risks 29 taken by rescuers and liberators, the citizens of the state are 30 encouraged to rededicate themselves to the principles of human 31 dignity and individual freedom in a just society, thereby 32 ensuring that such atrocities are never repeated, NOW, 33 THEREFORE, 34 35 Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of 36 Florida: 37 That the week of April 27 through May 4, 2014, is 38 39 designated as the "Days of Remembrance" and April 28, 2014, is 40 designated as "Holocaust Remembrance Day" in the State of Florida. 41
