4 Remove lines 370-383 and insert:

5 (4) HUMAN IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS TESTING REQUIREMENTS;  
6 REGISTRATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH; EXEMPTIONS FROM  
7 REGISTRATION.—No county health department and no other person in  
8 this state shall conduct or hold themselves out to the public as  
9 conducting a testing program for acquired immune deficiency  
10 syndrome or human immunodeficiency virus status without first  
11 registering with the Department of Health, reregistering each  
12 year, complying with all other applicable provisions of state  
13 law, and meeting the following requirements:

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14 (d) The program must meet all of the requirements ~~informed~~  
15 ~~consent criteria contained~~ in subsection (2).

16 (j) Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to  
17 require a facility licensed under chapter 395 or chapter 483 or  
18 a person licensed under the provisions of chapter 457, chapter  
19 458, chapter 459, chapter 460, chapter 461, chapter 466, or  
20 chapter 467 to register with the Department of Health and comply  
21 with the requirements of this subsection if the testing program  
22 is part of routine medical care or if the facility or person  
23 does not advertise to the general public that the facility or  
24 person conducts ~~if he or she does not advertise or hold himself~~  
25 ~~or herself out to the public as conducting~~ testing programs for  
26 human immunodeficiency virus infection or specializes  
27 ~~specializing~~ in such testing.
