**Amendment (with title amendment)**

Remove lines 29-68 and insert:

24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution. This exemption applies to such confidential and exempt information held by an agency before, on, or after the effective date of the exemption.

(b) Information about the location of a safe house, safe foster home, or other residential facility serving victims of sexual exploitation, as defined in s. 39.01(69)(g), may be provided to an agency, as defined in s. 119.011, as necessary to maintain health and safety standards and to address emergency situations in the safe house, safe foster home, or other residential facility.

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15 (c) This subsection is subject to the Open Government  
16 Sunset Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand  
17 repealed on October 2, 2020, unless reviewed and saved from  
18 repeal through reenactment by the Legislature.

19 Section 2. Subsection (9) is added to section 787.06,  
20 Florida Statutes, to read:

21 787.06 Human trafficking.-

22 (9) (a) Information about the location of a residential  
23 facility offering services for adult victims of human  
24 trafficking involving commercial sexual activity, which is held  
25 by an agency, as defined in s. 119.011, is confidential and  
26 exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State  
27 Constitution. This exemption applies to such confidential and  
28 exempt information held by an agency before, on, or after the  
29 effective date of the exemption.

30 (b) Information about the location of a residential  
31 facility offering services for adult victims of human  
32 trafficking involving commercial sexual activity may be provided  
33 to an agency, as defined in s. 119.011, as necessary to maintain  
34 health and safety standards and to address emergency situations  
35 in the residential facility.

36 (c) This subsection is subject to the Open Government  
37 Sunset Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand  
38 repealed on October 2, 2020, unless reviewed and saved from  
39 repeal through reenactment by the Legislature.

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40           Section 3. The Legislature finds that it is a public  
41 necessity that information about the location of safe houses,  
42 safe foster homes, and other residential facilities serving  
43 victims of sexual exploitation, as defined in s. 39.01(69)(g),  
44 Florida Statutes, or adult victims of human trafficking  
45 involving commercial sexual activity, held by an agency, as  
46 defined in s. 119.011, Florida Statutes, be made confidential  
47 and exempt from s. 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and s. 24(a),  
48 Article I of the State Constitution. The Legislature also finds  
49 that it is a public necessity that the exemptions apply to such  
50 information held by an agency before, on, or after the effective
