5 Remove everything after the enacting clause and insert:

6 Section 1. Subsection (3) of section 265.111, Florida
 7 Statutes, is amended to read:

8 265.111 Capitol Complex; monuments.—

9 (3) The Department of Management Services, in consultation
 10 with the Florida Historical Commission, shall set aside an area
 11 of the Capitol Complex, not including the State Capital Circle
 12 Office Complex, and dedicate a memorial garden on which
 13 authorized monuments shall be placed. The memorial garden must
 14 include a monument in remembrance of the 241 members of the
 15 United States Armed Forces who lost their lives on October 23,
 16 1983, in Beirut, Lebanon.

17 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
