7 (1) The department may deny an application for an a
 8 operating permit, suspend or revoke a permit issued to any
 9 person or public body, or impose an administrative fine upon the
 10 failure of such person or public body to comply with the
 11 provisions of this chapter, the original approved plans and
 12 specifications or variances, the Florida Building Code adopted
 13 under chapter 553 applicable to public pools or public bathing
 14 places, or the rules adopted hereunder.

15 (2) The department may impose an administrative fine,
 16 which shall not exceed \$500 for each violation, for the
 17 violation of this chapter, the original approved plans and

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18 specifications or variances, the Florida Building Code adopted
19 under chapter 553 applicable to public pools or public bathing
20 places, or the rules adopted hereunder and for the violation of
21 ~~any of the provisions of~~ chapter 386. Notice of intent to impose
22 such fine shall be given by the department to the alleged
23 violator. Each day that a violation continues may constitute a
24 separate violation.

25 (5) Under conditions specified by rule, the department may
26 close a public pool that is not in compliance with this chapter,
27 the original approved plans and specifications or variances, the
28 Florida Building Code adopted under chapter 553 applicable to
29 public pools or public bathing places, or the rules adopted
30 under this chapter.
