Section 1. Section 448.115, Florida Statutes, is created to
read:
448.115 Protection of licensed health care workers
(1) As used in this section, the term:
(a) "Employer" means a hospital, medical or health care
facility, individual, firm, partnership, institution,
governmental entity, corporation, or association that employs a
licensed health care worker.
(b) "Licensed health care worker" means an individual
licensed under chapter 464 or chapter 468.
(2) An employer may not discipline, threaten with
discipline, or take retaliatory personnel action against a
licensed health care worker in the employment of the employer
because the licensed health care worker refuses to take an
assignment that is outside of his or her competency or that
would give rise to grounds for discipline against the licensed
health care worker under s. 456.072(1)(o), s. 464.018(1)(n), or
s. 468.365(1)(m) or (1)(n).
Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2015.
