7 Section 3. Section 316.0275, Florida Statutes, is created

9 316.0275 Noncriminal traffic infractions leading to
10 serious bodily injury or death; reclassification.-

11 (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if an
12 individual commits a noncriminal traffic infraction under this
13 chapter which causes serious bodily injury or death to a person
14 and within 5 years after that violation, commits another
15 noncriminal traffic infraction under this chapter which causes
16 serious bodily injury or death to a person, the second such
17 violation shall be reclassified as a misdemeanor of the first

18 degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083, and
19 have their license revoked under s. 322.26(10).

20 (2) As used in this section, the term "serious bodily
21 injury" means an injury to a person, excluding the at fault
22 driver, which consists of a physical condition that creates a
23 substantial risk of death, serious personal disfigurement, or
24 protracted loss or impairment of the function of any bodily
25 member or organ.

26 Section 4. Subsection (10) is added to section 322.26,
27 Florida Statutes, to read:

28 322.26 Mandatory revocation of license by department.—The
