6 Between lines 82 and 83 of the amendment, insert:

7 Section 5. Paragraph (a) of subsection (12) of section
8 790.06, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

9 790.06 License to carry concealed weapon or firearm.—

10 (12) (a) A license issued under this section does not
11 authorize any person to openly carry a handgun or carry a
12 concealed weapon or firearm into:

- 13 1. Any place of nuisance as defined in s. 823.05;
14 2. Any police, sheriff, or highway patrol station;
15 3. Any detention facility, prison, or jail;
16 4. Any courthouse;

17 5. Any courtroom, except that nothing in this section
18 would preclude a judge from carrying a concealed weapon or
19 determining who will carry a concealed weapon in his or her
20 courtroom;

21 6. Any polling place;

22 7. Any meeting of the governing body of a county, public
23 school district, municipality, or special district;

24 8. Any meeting of the Legislature or a committee thereof,
25 except that nothing in this section would preclude a member of
26 the Legislature from carrying a concealed weapon or concealed
27 firearm;

28 9. Any school, college, or professional athletic event not
29 related to firearms;

30 10. Any elementary or secondary school facility or
31 administration building;

32 11. Any career center;

33 12. Any portion of an establishment licensed to dispense
34 alcoholic beverages for consumption on the premises, which
35 portion of the establishment is primarily devoted to such
36 purpose;

37 13. Any college or university facility unless the licensee
38 is a registered student, employee, or faculty member of such
39 college or university and the weapon is a stun gun or nonlethal
40 electric weapon or device designed solely for defensive purposes
41 and the weapon does not fire a dart or projectile;

42 14. The inside of the passenger terminal and sterile area
43 of any airport, provided that no person shall be prohibited from
44 carrying any legal firearm into the terminal, which firearm is
45 encased for shipment for purposes of checking such firearm as
46 baggage to be lawfully transported on any aircraft; or

47 15. Any place where the carrying of firearms is prohibited
48 by federal law.
