5 Between lines 235 and 236, insert:

6 Section 5. Subsection (17) of section 1007.271, Florida
 7 Statutes, is amended to read:

8 1007.271 Dual enrollment programs.—

9 (17) Instructional materials assigned for use within dual
 10 enrollment courses shall be made available to dual enrollment
 11 students from Florida public high schools free of charge. This
 12 subsection does not prohibit a Florida College System
 13 institution from providing instructional materials at no cost to
 14 a home education student or student from a private school.
 15 Instructional materials purchased by a district school board or
 16 Florida College System institution board of trustees on behalf
 17 of dual enrollment students shall be the property of the board

19 student and his or her parent must be provided a syllabus for
20 each course in which the student is enrolled. The syllabus must
21 provide a complete listing by title of the instructional
