6 Between lines 86 and 87 of the amendment, insert:

7 (d) The contest operator shall offer training to employees
 8 on responsible play and shall work with a compulsive or
 9 addictive behavior prevention program to recognize problem
 10 situations, to implement responsible play and practices, and to
 11 implement underage player protections.

12 1. The department shall, subject to competitive bidding,
 13 contract for provision of services related to the prevention of
 14 compulsive and addictive play. The contract shall provide for an
 15 advertising program to encourage responsible practices and to
 16 publicize a telephone help line. The terms of any contract for
 17 the provision of such services shall include accountability

18 standards that must be met by any private provider. The failure
19 of any private provider to meet any material terms of the
20 contract, including the accountability standards, shall
21 constitute a breach of contract or grounds for nonrenewal.

22 2. The compulsive or addictive play prevention program
23 shall be funded by the allocation of 7.5% of the initial
24 registration fee and any subsequent renewal registration fee
25 paid by the contest operator to the department.
