Section 1. Paragraphs (ffff) through (pppp) are added to subsection (4) of section 320.08056, Florida Statutes, to read:

320.08056 Specialty license plates.—

(4) The following license plate annual use fees shall be collected for the appropriate specialty license plates:

(ffff) Support Special Needs Kids license plate, \$25.

(gggg) America the Beautiful license plate, \$25.

(hhhh) Ducks Unlimited license plate, \$25.

(iiii) Bonefish and Tarpon Trust license plate, \$25.

(jjjj) Educate Engage Empower license plate, \$25.

21 Section 2. Subsections (30) and (66) of section 320.08058,
22 Florida Statutes, are amended, and subsections (84) through (94)

24 Between lines 266 and 267, insert:

25 (94) DIABETES AWARENESS LICENSE PLATES.—

26 (a) The department shall develop a Diabetes Awareness
27 license plate as provided in this section and s. 320.08053. The
28 plate must bear the colors and design approved by the
29 department. The word "Florida" must appear at the top of the
30 plate, and the words "Diabetes Awareness" must appear at the
31 bottom of the plate.

32 (b) The department shall retain all annual use fees from
33 the sale of such plates until all startup costs for developing
34 and issuing the plates have been recovered. Thereafter, the
35 annual use fees from the sale of the plate shall be remitted to
36 the Department of Health for distribution as follows:

37 1. Thirty-five percent shall be retained by the Department
38 of Health and used for diabetes-specific health services for
39 state residents. Of this amount, up to 10 percent may be used
40 for administrative and marketing expenses.

41 2. Thirty-five percent shall be distributed to the Florida
42 American Diabetes Association, Inc., which may use up to 5
43 percent of this amount for administrative expenses and the
44 remainder for scholarships in health fields to promote health
45 and wellness among minority populations and diabetes awareness
46 based on identified needs.

47 3. Thirty percent shall be distributed to LIFT Health,
48 Inc., a charitable, not-for-profit organization under s.
49 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and sponsor of the Arthur
50 Green Jr. Memorial Foundation, for use as grants to promote
51 community engagement, education, scholarships, research, and the
52 public policy impact in the state and to provide medical
53 identification bracelets to persons with diabetes. Of this
54 amount, up to 5 percent may be used for administrative and
55 marketing expenses.
