Between lines 319 and 320, insert:

Section 5. Subsection (9) of section 382.003, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

382.003 Powers and duties of the department.—The department shall:

(9) Appoint one or more suitable persons to act as subregistrars, who shall be authorized to produce and maintain paper death certificates and fetal death certificates, and to issue burial-transit permits in and for such portions of one or more districts as may be designated, and to issue certified copies of original certificates of death. A subregistrar may be removed from office by the department for neglect of or failure

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18 to perform his or her duty in accordance with this chapter. The
19 department shall promulgate rules for subregistrars to issue
20 certified copies of original certificates of death.

21 Section 6. Subsection (4) of section 382.025, Florida
22 Statutes, is amended to read:

23 382.025 Certified copies of vital records;
24 confidentiality; research.—

25 (4) CERTIFIED COPIES OF ORIGINAL CERTIFICATES.—Only the
26 state registrar, ~~and~~ local registrars, and subregistrars are
27 authorized to issue any certificate which purports to be a
28 certified copy of an original certificate of live birth, death,
29 or fetal death. Except as provided in this section, preparing or
30 issuing certificates is exempt from the provisions of s.
31 119.07(1).

32 Section 7. Subsection (2) of section 382.0255, Florida
33 Statutes, is amended, and new subsection (5) is added to read:

34 382.0255 Fees.—

35 (2) The fee charged for each request for a certification
36 of a birth record issued by the department or by the local
37 registrar shall be subject to an additional fee of \$4 which
38 shall be deposited in the appropriate departmental trust fund.
39 On a quarterly basis, the department shall transfer \$1.50 to the
40 Child Welfare Training Trust Fund created in s. 402.40. The fee
41 charged by a subregistrar for each request for a certified copy
42 of an original certificate of death shall not exceed \$5 and

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43 shall be remitted to the department for deposit in the Planning
44 and Evaluation Trust Fund.

45 (5) Notwithstanding s. 406.06, no fee shall be charged for
46 any determination of the cause of death under s. 406.11 or for
47 any certification of the cause of death under s. 382.008.
