The annual use fees from the sale of the plates shall 32 (b) 33 be distributed to the Department of Legal Affairs, which: 34 1. May use up to 15 percent of the proceeds to promote and 35 market the license plate. 36 2. 59	later than December 31. The Department of Legal Affairs shall
