House Amendment 1 – 766465 to Senate Amendment – 773730 (body with title)

II. Summary of Amendments Contained in Message:

House Amendment 1 deletes all provisions pertaining to the consumer advocate. In the Senate amendment, the consumer advocate is tasked with assisting uninsured patients in understanding their health care bills related to nonemergency health care services provided in a hospital or ambulatory surgical center and advocating on behalf of uninsured patients when negotiations between the patient, or the patient's representative, and the health care provider fail to achieve charges within a range that is common to similarly situated patients or access to available financial assistance.
