Amendment (with title amendment)

Remove lines 75-105 and insert:

7 b. Upon the second occurrence of noncompliance, temporary
 8 cash assistance for the child or children in a family who are
 9 under age 16 may be continued for the first 3 months of the
 10 penalty period through a protective payee as specified in
 11 subsection (2).

12 3. Third noncompliance:

13 a. Temporary cash assistance shall be terminated for the
 14 family for 6 ~~3~~ months or until the individual who failed to
 15 comply does so, whichever is later. The individual shall be
 16 required to comply with the required work activity upon
 17 completion of the 6-month ~~3-month~~ penalty period, before

18 reinstatement of temporary cash assistance. Upon meeting this
19 requirement, temporary cash assistance shall be reinstated to
20 the date of compliance or the first day of the month following
21 the penalty period, whichever is later.

22 b. Upon the third occurrence of noncompliance, temporary
23 cash assistance for the child or children in a family who are
24 under age 16 may be continued for the first 6 months of the
25 penalty period through a protective payee as specified in
26 subsection (2).

27 4. Fourth noncompliance:

28 a. Temporary cash assistance shall be terminated for the
29 family for 12 months, or until the individual who failed to
30 comply does so, whichever is later. The individual shall be
31 required to comply with the required work activity upon
32 completion of the 12-month penalty period and reapply before
33 reinstatement of temporary cash assistance. Upon meeting this
34 requirement, temporary cash assistance shall be reinstated to
35 the first day of the month following the penalty period.

36 b. Upon the fourth occurrence of noncompliance, temporary
37 cash assistance for the child or children in a family who are
38 under age 16 may be continued for the first 12 months of the
39 penalty period through a protective payee as specified in
40 subsection (2).

41 5. Nothing in this paragraph prohibits a participant from
42 complying with the work activity requirements during the penalty
43 periods imposed in paragraph (a).
