An act relating to specialty license plates; amending s. 320.08053, F.S.; revising presale requirements for issuance of a specialty plate; amending s. 320.08056, F.S.; revising conditions for discontinuing issuance of a specialty plate; providing an additional exception to the minimum requirements for certain specialty plates; amending ss. 320.08056 and 320.08058, F.S.; revising the name of a certain specialty license plate; establishing annual use fees for certain specialty license plates; adding certain North American Soccer League teams for the Florida Professional Sports Team license plate; redefining the term "major sports events"; revising requirements relating to the distribution and use of annual use fees collected from the sale of certain specialty license plates; directing the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to develop certain specialty license plates; providing for distribution and use of fees collected from the sale of the plates; providing effective dates.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Effective July 1, 2016, section 320.08053,
Florida Statutes, is amended to read:



27 320.08053 <u>Establishment of</u> Requirements for requests to 28 establish specialty license plates.-

(1) If a specialty license plate requested by an organization is approved by law, the organization must submit the proposed art design for the specialty license plate to the department, in a medium prescribed by the department, as soon as practicable, but no later than 60 days after the act approving the specialty license plate becomes a law.

35 (2) (a) Within 120 days following the specialty license 36 plate becoming law, the department shall establish a method to issue a specialty license plate voucher to allow for the presale 37 38 of the specialty license plate. The processing fee as prescribed 39 in s. 320.08056, the service charge and branch fee as prescribed in s. 320.04, and the annual use fee as prescribed in s. 40 41 320.08056 shall be charged for the voucher. All other applicable fees shall be charged at the time of issuance of the license 42 43 plates.

44 (b) Within 24 months after the presale specialty license 45 plate voucher is established, the approved specialty license 46 plate organization must record with the department a minimum of 47 4,000 1,000 voucher sales before manufacture of the license 48 plate may begin commence. If, at the conclusion of the 24-month presale period, the minimum sales requirement has requirements 49 50 have not been met, the specialty plate is deauthorized and the 51 department shall discontinue development of the plate and 52 discontinue issuance of the presale vouchers. Upon 53 deauthorization of the license plate, a purchaser of the license plate voucher may use the annual use fee collected as a credit 54 55 towards any other specialty license plate or apply for a refund

57 Section 2. Effective July 1, 2018, paragraph (a) of 58 subsection (8) of section 320.08056, Florida Statutes, is 59 amended to read:

61 (8) (a) The department must discontinue the issuance of an 62 approved specialty license plate if the number of valid specialty plate registrations falls below 4,000 1,000 plates for 63 64 at least 12 consecutive months. A warning letter shall be mailed 65 to the sponsoring organization following the first month in 66 which the total number of valid specialty plate registrations is 67 below 4,000 1,000 plates. Fifty-five percent of the proceeds from the Florida 128 129 Professional Sports Team plate must be deposited into the 130 Professional Sports Development Trust Fund within the Department of Economic Opportunity. These funds must be used solely to 131 132 attract and support major sports events in this state. As used 133 in this subparagraph, the term "major sports events" means, but 134 is not limited to, championship or all-star contests of Major League Baseball, the National Basketball Association, the 135 136 National Football League, the National Hockey League, Major 137 League Soccer, the North American Soccer League, the men's and 138 women's National Collegiate Athletic Association Final Four 139 basketball championship, or a horseracing or dogracing Breeders' 140 Cup. All funds must be used to support and promote major 141 sporting events, and the uses must be approved by the Department 142 of Economic Opportunity.



143 2. The remaining proceeds of the Florida Professional 144 Sports Team license plate must be allocated to Enterprise 145 Florida, Inc. These funds must be deposited into the 146 Professional Sports Development Trust Fund within the Department 147 of Economic Opportunity. These funds must be used by Enterprise 148 Florida, Inc., to promote the economic development of the sports 149 industry; to distribute licensing and royalty fees to 150 participating professional sports teams; to promote education 151 programs in Florida schools that provide an awareness of the 152 benefits of physical activity and nutrition standards; to 153 partner with the Department of Education and the Department of 154 Health to develop a program that recognizes schools whose 155 students demonstrate excellent physical fitness or fitness 156 improvement; to institute a grant program for communities 157 bidding on minor sporting events that create an economic impact 158 for the state; to distribute funds to Florida-based charities 159 designated by Enterprise Florida, Inc., and the participating 160 professional sports teams; and to fulfill the sports promotion 161 responsibilities of the Department of Economic Opportunity.

3. Enterprise Florida, Inc., shall provide an annual 162 163 financial audit in accordance with s. 215.981 of its financial 164 accounts and records by an independent certified public 165 accountant pursuant to the contract established by the 166 Department of Economic Opportunity. The auditor shall submit the 167 audit report to the Department of Economic Opportunity for 168 review and approval. If the audit report is approved, the 169 Department of Economic Opportunity shall certify the audit report to the Auditor General for review. 170
