Section 3. Notwithstanding s. 381.986(5)(b), Florida Statutes, a dispensing organization that receives notice from the Department of Health that it is approved as a region's dispensing organization, posts a \$5 million performance bond in compliance with rule 64-4.002(5)(e), Florida Administrative Code, meets the requirements of and requests cultivation authorization pursuant to rule 64-4.005(2), Florida

Administrative Code, and expends at least \$100,000 to fulfill its legal obligations as a dispensing organization; or any applicant that would have received notice of such approval from the Department of Health but for an erroneous finding that the applicant failed to meet the requirements of that section must be granted cultivation authorization by the Department of Health and is authorized to operate as a dispensing organization for the full term of its original approval and all subsequent renewals pursuant to s. 381.986, Florida Statutes. An action at any time by the Division of Administrative Hearings, the Department of Health, or a court having jurisdiction which has the effect of approving a dispensing organization that does not meet the criteria of this section, does not impair the authorization granted herein to a dispensing organization that meets the criteria of this section. Any dispensing organization approvals resulting from orders of the Division of Administrative Hearings, the Department of Health, or a court having jurisdiction shall be in addition to the five dispensing organizations authorized by s. 381.986(5)(b). During the operation of any dispensing organization meeting the criteria in this section, the Department of Health may enforce rule 64-4.005, Florida Administrative Code, as filed on June 17, 2015.
