 2           An act relating to the state employees' prescription  
 3           drug program; amending s. 110.12315, F.S.; requiring  
 4           the Department of Management Services to implement  
 5           formulary management cost-saving measures; providing  
 6           requirements for such measures; providing an effective  
 7           date.

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 9   Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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 11           Section 1. Subsection (9) of section 110.12315, Florida  
 12           Statutes, is amended to read:

13           110.12315 Prescription drug program.—The state employees'  
 14           prescription drug program is established. This program shall be  
 15           administered by the Department of Management Services, according  
 16           to the terms and conditions of the plan as established by the  
 17           relevant provisions of the annual General Appropriations Act and  
 18           implementing legislation, subject to the following conditions:

19           (9) The department shall implement formulary management  
 20           ~~such additional~~ cost-saving measures. Such measures must require  
 21           prescription drugs to be subject to formulary inclusion or  
 22           exclusion and may not restrict access to the most clinically  
 23           appropriate, clinically effective, and lowest net-cost  
 24           prescription drugs. However, excluded drugs may be available for  
 25           inclusion if a physician, advanced registered nurse

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26 | practitioner, or physician assistant prescribing a  
27 | pharmaceutical clearly states on the prescription that the  
28 | excluded drug is medically necessary ~~and adjustments as may be~~  
29 | ~~required to balance program funding within appropriations~~  
30 | ~~provided, including a trial or starter dose program and~~  
31 | ~~dispensing of long-term-maintenance medication in lieu of acute~~  
32 | ~~therapy medication.~~

33 | Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017.
