an arrest or incident of alleged criminal activity of an adult charged with a felony, misdemeanor, or violation of a comparable rule or ordinance by a state, county, municipal, or other law enforcement agency upon notification by the clerk of the court, pursuant to s. 943.052(2), that all the charges related to the arrest or incident of alleged criminal activity were declined to be filed by the state attorney or statewide prosecutor or dismissed or nolle prosequi before trial, or resulted in a judgment of acquittal or verdict of not quilty at trial.
