(f) Notwithstanding the provisions of this subsection, a patient who is not a permanent resident of this state and holds a valid patient identification card or its equivalent which was issued within his or her state of permanent residence shall be treated as a qualified patient upon the presentation of such identification card or its equivalent and shall be entered into the medical marijuana registry established in subsection (5).
