Section 1. Paragraph (a) of subsection (3) of section 11.143, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

11.143 Standing or select committees; powers.—

(3) (a) In order to carry out its duties, each such committee, whenever required, may issue subpoena and other necessary process to compel the attendance of witnesses before such committee, and the chair thereof shall issue the process on behalf of the committee, in accordance with the rules of the respective house. The chair or any other member of such committee shall may administer all oaths and affirmations in the manner prescribed by law to witnesses who appear before the committee for the purpose of testifying in any matter concerning which the committee desires evidence.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017.
