Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 945.21504, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

945.21504 Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund.-

(1) The Federal Law Enforcement Trust Fund is created within the Department of Corrections. The department may deposit into the trust fund receipts and revenues received as a result of federal criminal, administrative, or forfeiture proceedings and receipts and revenues received from federal asset-sharing programs to support law enforcement activities within the department.

(2) Notwithstanding s. 216.301 and pursuant to s. 216.351, any balance in the trust fund at the end of any fiscal year will remain in the trust fund and be available for carrying out the purposes of the trust fund. The trust fund is exempt from the service charges imposed by s. 215.20.

(3) In accordance with s. 19(f)(2), Art. III of the State
