Such value shall be added to the total full-35 time equivalent student membership in basic programs for grades 36 37 9 through 12 in the subsequent fiscal year. The school district shall distribute to each classroom teacher who provided Advanced 38 39 International Certificate of Education instruction: 1. A bonus in the amount of \$50 for each student taught by 40

the Advanced International Certificate of Education teacher in 41 each full-credit Advanced International Certificate of Education 42 43 course who receives a score of E or higher on the Advanced International Certificate of Education examination.
