6 provided the customer notifies the alarm monitoring company that
7 he or she holds such license and would like to bypass the two-
8 call verification protocol. Upon initiation of a new alarm
9 monitoring service contract, the alarm monitoring company shall
10 make reasonable efforts to inform a customer who holds a valid
11 federal firearms license as a manufacturer, importer, or dealer
12 of firearms or ammunition of his or her right to opt out of the
13 two-call verification protocol.
