Remove line 20 and insert:

Section 1. Section 565.04, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

565.04 Package store licenses, regulations and fees  
~~restrictions.~~

(1) The term "liquor package store," as used in this  
section, means: (a) vendors who pay state license taxes under s.  
565.02(1)(a); (b) who are permitted to sell any alcoholic  
beverages regardless of alcoholic content; and (3) operate a  
place of business where beverages are sold only in sealed  
containers for consumption off the premises where sold.

17           (2) The division is authorized to issue Type A liquor  
18 package store licenses, and Type B liquor package store  
19 licenses, subject to the following:

20           (a) Type A liquor package store licenses may be issued to a  
21 vendor with a premises without openings permitting direct access  
22 to any other building or room, except to a private office or  
23 storage room of the place of business from which patrons are  
24 excluded. Such liquor package stores ~~vendors licensed under s.~~  
25 ~~565.02(1)(a)~~ shall not in the licensed premises ~~said place of~~  
26 ~~business~~ sell, offer, or expose for sale any merchandise other  
27 than such beverages, and such liquor package stores ~~places of~~  
28 ~~business~~ shall be devoted exclusively to such sales; provided,  
29 however, that such vendors shall be permitted to sell bitters,  
30 grenadine, nonalcoholic mixer-type beverages (not to include  
31 fruit juices produced outside this state), fruit juices produced  
32 in this state, home bar, and party supplies and equipment  
33 (including but not limited to glassware and party-type foods),  
34 miniatures of no alcoholic content, and tobacco products. ~~Such~~  
35 ~~places of business shall have no openings permitting direct~~  
36 ~~access to any other building or room, except to a private office~~  
37 ~~or storage room of the place of business from which patrons are~~  
38 ~~excluded.~~ A Type A liquor package store shall pay an annual  
39 license fee pursuant to s. 565.02(1)(a).

40 (b) Type B liquor package store licenses may be issued to a  
41 vendor that is not subject to the limitations contained in  
42 subsection (2) (a), subject to the following conditions:

43 1. Type B liquor package store licensees shall pay an  
44 annual license fee equal to the sum of the annual license fee  
45 pursuant to s. 565.02(1) (a); and

46 2. Shall pay an additional amount according to the  
47 population of the county where the vendor operates and provided  
48 for herein:

49 a. Vendors operating places of business in counties having  
50 a population of over 100,000, according to the latest population  
51 estimate prepared pursuant to s. 186.901, for such county, shall  
52 pay \$294 in addition to the annual license fee.

53 b. Vendors operating places of business in counties having  
54 a population of over 75,000 and not over 100,000, according to  
55 the latest population estimate prepared pursuant to s. 186.901,  
56 for such county, shall pay \$252 in addition to the annual  
57 license fee.

58 c. Vendors operating places of business in counties having  
59 a population of over 50,000 and less than 75,000, according to  
60 the latest population estimate prepared pursuant to s. 186.901,  
61 for such county, shall pay \$210 in addition to the annual  
62 license fee.

63 d. Vendors operating places of business in counties having  
64 a population of over 25,000 and less than 50,000, according to

66 for such county, shall pay \$168 in addition to the annual  
67 license fee.

68 e. Vendors operating places of business in counties having  
69 a population of less than 25,000, according to the latest

71 county, shall pay \$126 in addition to the annual license fee.
