Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

An act relating to suspension of civil rights;

Section 1. Subsection (1) of section 944.292, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

944.292 Suspension of civil rights.—

(1) Upon conviction of a <u>life or capital</u> felony <u>as or a</u> forcible felony as defined in s. 776.08 defined in s. 10, Art. X of the State Constitution, the civil rights of the person convicted shall be suspended in Florida until such rights are restored by a full pardon, conditional pardon, or restoration of civil rights granted pursuant to s. 8, Art. IV of the State Constitution.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2017.
