5 Between lines 2830 and 2831, insert:

6 Section 51. Tax on firearms and ammunition.-

7 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, there is imposed a tax
8 upon the sale of ammunition in this state at the rate of one
9 cent per piece of ammunition and a tax of 1 percent of the sales
10 price of each firearm sold in the state. Revenue generated and
11 collected under the tax imposed by this section shall be used to
12 provide a grant of \$500 to each teacher who qualifies for the
13 Coach Aaron Feis Guardian Program but declines to participate in

14 the program. The funds shall be used only for the purchase of
15 school supplies. The funds shall be provided to the teacher by
16 direct deposit. The teacher shall supply his or her principal
17 with receipts to verify that the funds were only spent for
18 purposes authorized under this section. Funds left unspent in a
19 teacher's account at the end of the school year shall be
20 returned to the General Revenue Fund of the state. The
21 Department of Revenue shall adopt rules to establish procedures
22 for the collection of the taxes under this section. The
23 department of Education shall adopt rules concerning the
24 distribution of funds from the taxes to teachers, proper
25 expenditure of the funds, and return of any unspent funds.
