Senator Braynon moved the following:

1 **Senate Amendment to Amendment (234288) (with title**
2 **amendment)**

4 Delete lines 35 - 80

5 and insert:

6 (k) Establish, if the sheriff so chooses, the School
7 Marshal Pilot Program as a voluntary pilot program in the school
8 districts in Citrus, Holmes, and Nassau Counties to aid in the
9 prevention or abatement of active assailant incidents on school
10 premises. A school marshal has no authority to act in any law
11 enforcement capacity except to the extent necessary to prevent

12 or abate an active assailant incident on a school premises. The
13 sheriff who chooses to establish the pilot program shall appoint
14 as school marshals, without the power of arrest, school
15 employees who volunteer and who:

16 1. Hold a valid license issued under s. 790.06.

17 2. Complete 132 total hours of comprehensive firearm safety
18 and proficiency training conducted by Criminal Justice Training
19 and Standards Commission-certified instructors, which must
20 include:

21 a. Eighty hours of firearms instruction based on the
22 Criminal Justice Standards and Training Commission's Law
23 Enforcement Academy training model, which must include at least
24 10 percent but no more than 20 percent more rounds fired than
25 associated with academy training. Pilot program participants
26 must achieve an 85 percent pass rate on the firearms training.

27 b. Sixteen hours of instruction in precision pistol.

28 c. Eight hours of discretionary shooting instruction using
29 state-of-the-art simulator exercises.

30 d. Eight hours of instruction in active shooter or
31 assailant scenarios.

32 e. Eight hours of instruction in defensive tactics.

33 f. Twelve hours of instruction in legal issues.

34 3. Pass a psychological evaluation administered by a
35 psychologist licensed under chapter 490 and designated by the
36 Department of Law Enforcement and submit the results of the
37 evaluation to the sheriff's office. The Department of Law
38 Enforcement is authorized to provide the sheriff's office with
39 mental health and substance abuse data for compliance with this
40 paragraph.

41 4. Submit to and pass an initial drug test and subsequent
42 random drug tests in accordance with the requirements of s.
43 112.0455 and the sheriff's office.

44 5. Successfully complete ongoing training, weapon
45 inspection, and firearm qualification on at least an annual
46 basis.

48 The sheriff shall issue a school marshal certificate to
49 individuals who meet the requirements of subparagraph 2. The
50 sheriff shall maintain documentation of weapon and equipment
51 inspections, as well as the training, certification, inspection,
52 and qualification records of each school marshal appointed by
53 the sheriff.
