- (c) If the law enforcement agency possesses reasonable suspicion that, under particular circumstances, swift action is needed to prevent imminent danger to life or serious damage to property;  $\tau$  to forestall the imminent escape of a suspect or the destruction of evidence; to facilitate the collection of evidence at a crime scene or traffic crash scene; or to achieve purposes including, but not limited to, facilitating the search for a missing person.
- (k) By a local or state agency when used in the assessment of damage, flood state, wildfire, or land management, or the monitoring and collection of scientific or marketing data.
