The home addresses, telephone numbers, dates of birth, and photographs of current or former directors, managers, supervisors, nurses, and clinical employees of a substance abuse service provider that is licensed under part II of chapter 397 and whose duties include the counseling and treatment of persons who have mental health or substance abuse disorders; the home

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- 11 addresses, telephone numbers, photographs, dates of birth, and 12 places of employment of the spouses and children of such 13 personnel; and the names and locations of schools and day care 14 facilities attended by the children of such personnel are exempt 15 from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State 16 Constitution. This sub-subparagraph is subject to the Open 17 Government Sunset Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand repealed on October 2, 2023, unless reviewed and 18 19 saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature.
 - 3. An agency that is the custodian of the information specified in subparagraph 2. and that is not the employer of the officer, employee, justice, judge, or other person specified in subparagraph 2. shall maintain the exempt status of that information only if the officer, employee, justice, judge, other person, or employing agency of the designated employee submits a written request for maintenance of the exemption to the custodial agency.
 - 4. The exemptions in this paragraph apply to information held by an agency before, on, or after the effective date of the exemption.
 - Section 2. (1) The Legislature finds that it is a public necessity that all of the following identifying and location information be exempt from s. 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and s. 24(a), Article I of the State Constitution:
 - (a) The home addresses, telephone numbers, dates of birth, and photographs of current or former directors, managers, supervisors, nurses, and clinical employees of a substance abuse service provider that is licensed under part II of chapter 397, Florida Statutes.
