- 6 (1) The Legislature finds that:
  - (a) Property owners who choose to use their property as a vacation rental have constitutionally protected property rights and other rights that must be protected, including the right to use their residential property as a vacation rental;



11 (b) Vacation rentals play a significant, unique, and 12 critical role in Florida's tourism industry, and that role is 13 different from that of public lodging establishments; 14 (c) There are factors unique to the ownership and operation 15 of a vacation rental; and 16 (d) Vacation rentals are residential in nature and, thus, 17 belong in residential neighborhoods. 18 (2) This part is created for the purpose of regulating the factors unique to vacation rentals.
