A bill to be entitled

An act relating to poll workers; amending s. 102.014, F.S.; removing a requirement that supervisors of elections work with certain communities to develop public-private programs for a certain purpose; prohibiting a supervisor of elections from authorizing certain entities or persons to recruit, supply, or otherwise staff a precinct with certain poll workers for an election; amending s. 102.021, F.S.; prohibiting a supervisor of elections from paying certain entities or persons for services provided by certain poll workers; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Subsection (6) of section 102.014, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

102.014 Poll worker recruitment and training.-

(6) Supervisors of elections shall work with the business and local community to develop public-private programs to ensure the recruitment of skilled inspectors and clerks. However, supervisors of elections may not directly or indirectly authorize an entity, or a person on behalf of an entity, to recruit, supply, or otherwise staff a precinct with inspectors or clerks for an election.

Section 2. Subsection (3) is added to section 102.021, Florida Statutes, to read:

102.021 Compensation of inspectors, clerks, and deputy sheriffs.— $\,$
