Publication 33 shall occur by posting the adjusted state minimum wage rate and 34 the effective date on the Internet home pages of the Department of Economic Opportunity and the Department of Revenue by October 35 36 15 of each year. In addition, to the extent funded in the 37 General Appropriations Act, the Department of Economic Opportunity shall provide written notice of the adjusted rate 38 39 and the effective date of the adjusted state minimum wage to all 40 employers registered in the most current reemployment assistance database. Such notice shall be mailed by November 15 of each 41 42 year using the addresses included in the database.
