1009.21 Determination of resident status for tuition purposes.—Students shall be classified as residents or nonresidents for the purpose of assessing tuition in postsecondary educational programs offered by charter technical career centers or career centers operated by school districts, in Florida College System institutions, and in state

- 2. Apply for enrollment in or are currently enrolled in a graduate or professional program at an institution of higher education in this state;
- 3. Submit an official postsecondary transcript as evidence of attendance and graduation; and
- 4. File with the institution of higher education an affidavit stating that the student will file an application to become a permanent resident of the United States at the earliest opportunity he or she is eligible to do so.
