An act relating to a strategic fuel reserve; creating the Florida Strategic Fuel Reserve Task Force within the Division of Emergency Management to develop a recommended strategic fuel reserve for natural emergencies and major disasters; requiring the division to provide administrative and support services to the task force; specifying the membership of the task force; requiring the task force to elect a chair and a vice chair; requiring the task force to submit a recommended plan to the Legislature; providing an expiration date; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. (1) The Florida Strategic Fuel Reserve Task

Force, a task force as defined in s. 20.03, Florida Statutes, is

created within the Division of Emergency Management within the

Executive Office of the Governor to develop a recommended

strategic fuel reserve plan for the state to respond to private

and public fuel needs in the event of natural emergencies or

major disasters, as specified in s. 252.34, Florida Statutes.

- (2) The division shall provide administrative and support services relating to the functions of the task force.
 - (3) The task force shall consist of the following members:
 - (a) Three persons appointed by the President of the Senate.
- (b) Three persons appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.

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30	(c) Three persons appointed by the Governor.
31	(4) The task force shall elect a chair and vice chair.
32	(5) The task force shall submit a recommended strategic
33	fuel reserve plan to the President of the Senate and the Speaker
34	of the House of Representatives by April 30, 2019.
35	(6) This section expires on June 30, 2019.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2018.
