**Senate Amendment (with title amendment)**

Delete lines 410 - 425

and insert:

Section 9. Section 790.222, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

790.222 Bump-fire stocks prohibited.—A person may not import into this state or transfer, distribute, sell, keep for sale, offer for sale, possess, or give to another person a bump-fire stock. A person who violates this section commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s.

12 775.083, or s. 775.084. As used in this section, the term "bump-  
13 fire stock" means any device used with or attached to a firearm  
14 which uses the recoil action of the firearm to increase its  
15 cyclic firing rate to a nearly automatic rate of fire or to  
16 increase the rate of fire to a faster rate than is possible for  
17 an individual to operate the firearm unassisted by such a  
18 device.
