Between lines 425 and 426
insert:

(3) POSSESSION.—Any person who possesses a bump-fire stock, or all of the parts necessary to build or assemble a bump-fire stock, must turn over the bump-fire stock, or all such parts, to his or her county sheriff's department within 90 days after this act becomes law. The sheriff's department shall certify and document the persons who have complied with this subsection and shall dispose of the bump-fire stock, or all such parts, in an

12 appropriate manner within a reasonable amount of time. A person
13 who violates this subsection commits a felony of the third
14 degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s.
