(16) UNIFORM TRAVEL POLICY.-

(a) Each county and county constitutional officer as defined in s. 1(d), Art. VIII of the State Constitution, shall adopt a uniform travel policy applicable to all public officers and employees consistent with the provisions of this section.

(b) Each municipality shall adopt a uniform travel policy applicable to all public officers and employees consistent with the provisions of this section or s. 166.021(9).

22        (b) Notwithstanding s. 112.061, the governing body of a  
23 municipality or an agency thereof may provide for a per diem and  
24 travel expense policy for its travelers which varies from the  
25 provisions of s. 112.061 except that such policy shall comply  
26 with the provisions of s. 112.061(3)(a)2 and (17). Any such  
27 policy provided by a municipality or an agency thereof on  
28 January 1, 2003, shall be valid and in effect for that  
29 municipality or agency thereof until otherwise amended. A  
30 municipality or agency thereof that provides any per diem and  
31 travel expense policy pursuant to this subsection shall be  
32 deemed to be exempt from all provisions of s. 112.061 except for  
33 s. 112.061(3)(a)2. and (17). A municipality or agency thereof  
34 that does not provide a per diem and travel expense policy  
35 pursuant to this subsection remains subject to all provisions of  
36 s. 112.061.
