14	Law Enforcement a de-escalation training pilot program to
15	provide grants to city or county law enforcement agencies to
16	implement de-escalation training for law enforcement officers.
17	The purpose of the program is to determine whether de-escalation
18	training reduces the number of use-of-force incidents within the
19	participating law enforcement agencies.
20	(2) The department shall implement a voluntary competitive
21	grant process for law enforcement agencies to participate in the
22	program. Grant recipients shall report the number of use-of-
23	force incidents to the department before and after the de-
24	escalation training is implemented in a manner prescribed by the
25	department.
