completed all terms of sentence for a felony conviction for an

his or her voting rights restored pursuant to s. 4, Art. VI of
the State Constitution is entitled to qualify for and hold

elective office in this state.

Section 78. If any provision of this act or an act passed by the Legislature relating to the implementation of s. 4, Article VI of the State Constitution is held to be invalid, the invalidity does not affect the provisions of this act which can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end this act is severable.
