Section 1. Subsection (21) is added to section 553.73, Florida Statutes, to read:

553.73 Florida Building Code. -

(21) The Florida Building Code must require all facilities that provide dialysis services to have an operational emergency power source. For purposes of this subsection, the term "emergency power source" means a system that provides an independent source of electric power during a loss of power supply and includes a supply of fuel sufficient to sustain the emergency power source for at least 7 days during a power outage. An emergency power system may include a generator, batteries, and other essential accessories needed to power the emergency power system.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2019.
