2	A memorial to the Congress of the United States,
3	urging Congress to call a convention under Article V
4	of the Constitution of the United States for the
5	exclusive purpose of proposing an amendment to the
6	Constitution of the United States to permanently
7	restore free and fair elections in the United States.

9	WHEREAS, the framers of the Constitution of the United
10	States intended that the United States Congress should be
11	"dependent on the people alone" (James Madison, Federalist No.
12	52), and
13	WHEREAS, that dependency has evolved from a dependency on
14	the people alone to a dependency on powerful special interests,
15	through campaigns or third-party groups, which has created a
16	fundamental imbalance in our representative democracy, and
17	WHEREAS, Americans across the political spectrum agree that
18	elections in the United States should be free from the
19	disproportional influence of special interests and fair enough
20	that any citizen can be elected to office, and
21	WHEREAS, Article I, Section 1 of the State Constitution
22	states that "all political power is inherent in the people," and
23	WHEREAS, Article V of the Constitution of the United States
24	requires Congress to call a convention for proposing amendments
25	to the Constitution of the United States on the application of
26	two-thirds of the legislatures of the several states, and
27	WHEREAS, multiple Florida counties and municipalities have
28	expressed by citizen referendum or through their elected
29	officials the need to free our elections from the

30-01730-20 20201816 30 disproportional influence of special interests, including, but 31 not limited to, Escambia, Gadsden, and Alachua Counties and the 32 cities of Key West, Sarasota, Tampa, and Miami, and WHEREAS, the Florida Legislature perceives the need for an 33 34 Article V convention in order to restore balance and integrity 35 to our elections by proposing an amendment to the Constitution 36 of the United States which will permanently restore free and 37 fair elections in the United States by addressing, among other things, issues raised by the decisions of the United States 38 39 Supreme Court in Citizens United v. Federal Election Commission, 40 558 U.S. 310 (2010), and related cases and events, and desires that such convention should be so limited, and 41 42 WHEREAS, the State of Florida desires that the delegates to such convention shall be composed equally of individuals 43 44 currently elected to state and local office, or be selected by 45

election, in each congressional district for the purpose of serving as delegates, though all individuals elected or appointed to federal office, past or present, shall be prohibited from serving as delegates to the convention, and the state intends to retain the ability to restrict or expand the power of its delegates within the limits expressed herein, and

51 WHEREAS, the State of Florida intends that this be a 52 continuing application considered together with applications 53 calling for a convention passed in the 2013-2014 Vermont 54 legislature as R454, the 2013-2014 California legislature as Resolution Chapter 77, the 98th Illinois General Assembly as SJR 55 56 42, the 2014-2015 New Jersey legislature as SCR 132, the 2015-57 2016 Rhode Island legislature as HR 7670 and SR 2589, and all 58 other passed, pending, and future applications until such time

63	Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

65	(1) That the Legislature of the State of Florida does
66	hereby make application to Congress, pursuant to Article V of
67	the Constitution of the United States, to call an Article V
68	Convention for the exclusive purpose of proposing an amendment
69	to the Constitution of the United States which will restore free
70	and fair elections by addressing the issues raised by the
71	decisions of the United States Supreme Court in Citizens United
72	v. Federal Election Commission, 558 U.S. 310 (2010), and related
73	cases and events.
74	(2) That this application constitutes a continuing
75	application in accordance with Article V of the Constitution of
76	the United States until the legislatures of at least two-thirds
77	of the several states have made application on the subject of
78	free and fair elections as specified in this application.
79	(3) That this application be aggregated with the
80	applications from other states on the same subject for the
81	purpose of attaining the two-thirds majority needed to require
82	Congress to call a limited Article V convention as specified in
83	this application, but not be aggregated with any other
84	applications on any other subject.
85	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of State dispatch
86	copies of this memorial to the President of the United States,
87	the President of the United States Senate, the Speaker of the
