18	SECTION 7. Passage of bills.—Any bill may originate in
19	either house and after passage in one may be amended in the
20	other; however, neither house may vote on a bill that would
21	affect access to abortion services unless at least half of the
22	members of that house are women. <u>A bill</u> It shall be read in each
23	house on three separate days, unless this <u>requirement</u> rule is
24	waived by two-thirds vote; provided the publication of its title
25	in the journal of a house shall satisfy the requirement for the
26	first reading in that house. On each reading, it shall be read
27	by title only, unless one-third of the members present desire it
28	read in full. On final passage, the vote of each member voting
29	shall be entered on the journal. Passage of a bill shall require

30	a majority vote in each house. Each bill and joint resolution
31	passed in both houses shall be signed by the presiding officers
32	of the respective houses and by the secretary of the senate and
33	the clerk of the house of representatives during the session or
34	as soon as practicable after its adjournment sine die.
