- (d) "Public building or facility" has the same meaning as in section 106.5 of the Florida Accessibility Code for Building Construction.
- (e) "Universal changing place" means an enclosed family or assisted-use restroom facility containing a powered, height-adjustable adult changing table that is either floor or wall mounted with a safety rail or safety belt and that can be used by a person of either sex, with his or her care provider, if applicable, for personal hygiene purposes.
- (2) A person, private firm, organization, corporation, or state or local government that operates a place of public accommodation or public building or facility shall install and maintain at least one universal changing place at each of the following locations in a family or assisted-use restroom facility for persons of either sex who have a physical disability:
- (a) Places of exhibition or entertainment, which include movie theaters, theaters, concert halls, sports arenas, and stadiums.
- (b) Shopping centers, shopping malls, or stores of at least 40,000 square feet.
- (c) Places of public display or collection, which include museums, libraries, and galleries.
 - (d) Places of recreation, which include parks, zoos, and

amusement parks.

- (e) Places of education, which include elementary, secondary, undergraduate, and postgraduate private or public schools.
- (f) Social service centers, which include senior centers and homeless shelters.
- (g) Public buildings or facilities, which include any state or local government buildings, rest areas, and state parks.
- (h) Stations used for public transportation, which include airport terminals, railway depots, and bus stations.
- (i) Professional offices of health care providers, which include hospitals and rehabilitation centers.
- (3) (a) The universal changing place must measure at least 8 feet by 10 feet, with adequate space for a wheelchair to maneuver; be equipped with a powered, height-adjustable adult changing table, a waste receptacle, a toilet, a sink or washbasin, a soap dispenser, and a paper towel dispenser; and comply with current accessibility requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act.
- (b) The powered, height-adjustable adult changing table in the universal changing place must:
- 1. Be able to lower to a height of no less than 8 inches and raise to height of no less than 34 inches;
 - 2. Be at least 25 inches in width by 70 inches in length;

- 3. Support up to at least 350 pounds.
- (c) A family or assisted-use restroom facility that has a universal changing place shall include signage at or near the entrance to the family or assisted-use restroom facility indicating that the facility has a universal changing place. If a place of public accommodation or public building or facility has a central directory identifying the location of offices, restrooms, and other facilities, the central directory shall indicate the location of each universal changing place in the place of public accommodation or public building or facility.
- (4) This section applies to any place of public accommodation or public building or facility that is open to the public and is:
 - (a) Built on or after January 1, 2021; or
- (b) An existing place of public accommodation or public building or facility that applies for a building permit on or after January 1, 2021, for a renovation of a main facility in the place of public accommodation or public building or facility, not including a parking garage, estimated to cost \$37,500 or more.
 - Section 2. This act shall take effect January 1, 2021.
