(a) Minimum standards shall include requirements for preadmission and periodic health examinations, requirements for immunizations, and requirements for maintaining emergency information and health records on all children. The standards shall include a minimum percentage of all children enrolled in

the child care facility who must have received immunizations. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2020.
