69	(1) A person who takes a bear or possesses a freshly killed
70	bear during the closed season prescribed by law or rules of the
71	commission commits a Level Three violation under s. 379.401 and
72	forfeits any license or permit issued to him or her under this
73	chapter for 3 years after the date of the violation. A person
74	who commits a subsequent offense of such taking or possession is
75	permanently ineligible for issuance of any license or permit
76	under this chapter.
77	(2) A person who possesses for sale or sells a bear taken
78	in violation of this section or rules of the commission commits
79	a Level Four violation under s. 379.401.
