(1)(a) Any personal identifying information of an applicant
for president of a state university is confidential and exempt
from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State
Constitution.
(b) The personal identifying information of an applicant

24	Constitution.
25	(b) A complete recording must be made of any portion of a
26	meeting that is closed pursuant to paragraph (a), and any closed
27	portion of such meeting may not be held off the record. The
28	recording of the closed portion of a meeting is exempt from s.
29	119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution.
30	(c) The public meeting exemption provided in paragraph (a)
31	does not apply to:
32	1. Any portion of a meeting held for the purpose of
33	establishing qualifications for the position or establishing any
34	compensation framework to be offered to an applicant for
35	president of a state university.
36	2. Any meeting held after a final group of applicants for
37	president of a state university has been established at which an
38	interview of an applicant is conducted or at which final action
39	or a vote is to be taken on the offer of the employment of an
40	applicant as president.

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41 (3) This section is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act in accordance with s. 119.15 and shall stand repealed 42 on October 2, 2025, unless reviewed and saved from repeal 43 44 through reenactment by the Legislature. 45 Section 2. The Legislature finds that it is a public 46 necessity that any personal identifying information of an 47 applicant for president of a state university be made confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and 48 s. 24(a), Article I of the State Constitution. The Legislature 49 50 also finds that it is a public necessity that any portion of a 51 meeting held for the purpose of identifying or vetting 52 applicants for president of a state university, including any 53 portion of a meeting that would disclose personal identifying 54 information of such applicants, be made exempt from s. 286.011, 55 Florida Statutes, and s. 24(b), Article I of the State 56 Constitution, and that the recording of such meeting be made 57 exempt from s. 119.07(1), Florida Statutes, and s. 24(a), Article I of the State Constitution. The task of filling the 58 59 position of president of a state university is often conducted 60 by an executive search committee. Many, if not most, applicants for such a position are currently employed at another job at the 61 62 time they apply and could jeopardize their current positions if 63 it were to become known that they were seeking employment 64 elsewhere. These exemptions from public records and public 65 meeting requirements are needed to ensure that such a search 66 committee can avail itself of the most experienced and desirable 67 pool of qualified applicants from which to fill the position of president of a state university. If potential applicants fear 68 69 the possibility of losing their current jobs as a consequence of

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70	attempting to progress along their chosen career path or simply
71	seeking different and more rewarding employment, failure to have
72	these safeguards in place could have a chilling effect on the
73	
	number and quality of applicants available to fill the position
74	of president of a state university.
